- You are individually to create a **digital poster or infographic** that addresses the sociological statement.
- Choose one of the statements below, which you will use as the theme of your poster.
 1. **Parsons** (1959a), woman play an 'expressive role': caring of others while men play an 'instrumental role' – providing for the family.
 2. **Social control** is linked to the idea that human behaviour involves a life-long process of rule-learning, underpinned by sanctions – the things we do to make people conform.
 3. **Bowles and Gintis** argue that there is a correspondence between school norms and workplace norms.
 4. **Media** may also promote changes in behaviour, such as campaigns against racism.
 5. **Religion** plays a significant role in the socialisation process, religion influence people by religious values therefore religious values are powerful forces for those who believe.
 6. **Foucault** (1983) claims power is exercised in increasingly modes way, such as technological surveillance; CCTV, smartphones to record people's behavior.
- The poster should demonstrate that you have knowledge of the statement being presented.
- This can be done as a powerpoint slide, or using a program of your choice use any Editing software (Photoshop, adobe illustrator, ebis paint, MediBang, etc).
- Explanation or description of the theme limited to 100-200 words must be attached in the poster.
